Day 1 – Depart the USA Begin your Transylvanian adventure as you depart the USA on an overnight flight to Bucharest, gateway to a land of medieval towns, majestic castles, mountain scenery, and rich cultural traditions. Relax onboard and enjoy meals and beverages as the anticipation builds for the unforgettable journey ahead.

Day 2 – Arrive in Romania | Bucharest – Braşov Welcome to Romania. Upon arrival at Bucharest International Airport, you will be met and transferred to Braşov, beautifully set amid the Carpathian Mountains. With its cobblestone streets, colorful baroque buildings, lively squares, and inviting cafés, Braşov offers a wonderfully romantic introduction to Transylvania. This charming city blends elegance, warmth, and old-world atmosphere in a setting that feels timeless and welcoming. Upon arrival, settle into your hotel and enjoy time to relax or perhaps step out for a breath of fresh mountain air and a first look at the enchanting Council Square. This evening, dinner is served at your hotel. (D)

Day 3 – Braşov | Sinaia, Peleş Castle and Prejmer After breakfast, set out for the lovely town of Sinaia, long associated with royal retreat and natural beauty. Here you will visit magnificent Peleş Castle, the 19th-century summer residence of Romania's royal family. Commissioned by King Carol I, this extraordinary castle is admired for its Neo-Renaissance architecture, richly decorated interiors, stained glass, fine furnishings, and remarkable art collections. After your visit, enjoy free time in Sinaia for a stroll and lunch at your leisure. In the afternoon, continue to Prejmer Fortified Church, one of Transylvania's most striking medieval monuments and part of the UNESCO-listed Villages. Founded in the 13th century by the Teutonic Knights, Prejmer offers a fascinating glimpse into Saxon heritage, with its mighty defensive walls and distinctive fortified design. Return to Braşov this evening with wonderful memories of a day filled with mountain beauty, royal history, and medieval character. (B)

Day 4 – Braşov | Historic Braşov and Bran Castle This morning, enjoy a guided walking tour through the historic heart of Braşov, one of Transylvania's most atmospheric and inviting cities. Discover highlights such as Council Square, the Black Church, Ecaterina's Gate, the Weavers' Bastion, and the White and Black Towers, while soaking in the city's rich Saxon heritage and storybook setting. Afterward, enjoy free time for lunch and the pleasure of wandering Braşov's charming old town at your own pace. Browse elegant boutiques, relax in cozy cafés, and shop for traditional Romanian treasures such as embroidered blouses, carved wooden crafts, Horezu pottery, local honey, and fruit preserves. In the afternoon, continue to dramatic Bran Castle,

perched on a rocky hill in the heart of Transylvania. Originally built as a medieval fortress in the late 14th century and later transformed into a beloved royal residence by Queen Marie, Bran Castle enchants visitors with its turrets, stone courtyards, winding staircases, and fairytale mountain setting. Forever linked to the mystique of the Dracula legend, the castle captures the romance, mystery, and Gothic allure that have made Transylvania famous throughout the world. After your visit, enjoy a little free time to browse the souvenir stalls before returning to Braşov. (B)

Day 5 – Braşov | Sighişoara – Sibiu After breakfast, depart Braşov and travel onward to Sighişoara, one of Transylvania's most enchanting medieval towns. This beautifully preserved UNESCO-listed citadel, founded by Transylvanian Saxons, welcomes visitors with pastel-colored houses, cobbled lanes, and storybook towers that evoke pure old-world charm. On your walking tour, discover some of its most memorable sights, including the Clock Tower, the Church on the Hill, the Scholar's Stairs, the Monastery Church, and several of the original guild towers that once protected the citadel. Lunch is included today at the famed House of Dracula Restaurant, birthplace of Vlad the Impaler in 1431. Afterward, enjoy free time to browse local craft and antique shops before continuing to elegant Sibiu, your new home for the next stage of your Romanian adventure. With its grand squares, pastel façades, and distinctive Transylvanian charm, Sibiu offers a refined and welcoming atmosphere. Check into your hotel and relax. This evening, perhaps enjoy a quiet stroll through the old town or settle into a local café and savor the timeless beauty of the city. (B,L)

Day 6 – Sibiu After breakfast, enjoy a relaxing free day in elegant Sibiu, where you can wander the medieval squares, admire the charming "eyes" of the old houses, visit local markets and artisan shops, sample traditional Romanian pastries or wine in a cozy café, and simply soak in the timeless atmosphere of one of Transylvania's most beautiful cities or take an optional tour to Alba Iulia and Sibiul Village. Depart for historic Alba Iulia, a city shaped by centuries of history and known for its grand avenues, imposing fortifications, and strong sense of heritage. Here you will visit the remarkable Alba Carolina Citadel, with its impressive Vauban-style fortification system, as well as the Orthodox Cathedral, Catholic Cathedral, and traces of the city's Roman past. Later, continue to the picturesque village of Sibiul, nestled in the scenic Mărginimea Sibiului region. This charming traditional village offers a glimpse into the slower rhythms of rural Transylvania, surrounded by pastoral beauty and enduring local customs. Enjoy a horse-drawn wagon ride through the village, followed by a visit to the Traditional Icons Museum. Here you will



enjoy a “Cultural Discovery” learning about how traditional icon art is made by local artisans. This evening, your day concludes with a “Cultural Discovery” a truly memorable traditional dinner, featuring a four-course meal with plum brandy, wine, water, and apple juice, all accompanied by live folk singers. It is a warm and authentic cultural experience that beautifully captures the spirit of Romania. (B,D)

Day 7 – Sibiu | Corvin Castle – Hunedoara After breakfast, enjoy a guided walking tour of Sibiu, one of Transylvania’s most elegant and historically important towns. Founded in the 12th century and long associated with the Transylvanian Saxons, Sibiu charms visitors with its medieval squares, towers, and graceful architecture. During your tour, discover the city’s Big Square, Small Square, Staircase Tower, the iconic Bridge of Lies, and the city’s three principal cathedrals: Orthodox, Lutheran-Evangelical, and Catholic. After some free time to relax, the day builds toward a memorable evening unlike any other. In the early evening, travel to one of Europe’s most haunted locations, Corvin Castle in Hunedoara, a dramatic 15th-century stronghold completed in 1453 and later expanded by Matthias Corvinus. With its soaring towers, grand halls, and storybook silhouette, the castle provides an extraordinary setting for tonight’s special event: a Cultural Evening and Halloween Party inside one of Europe’s most atmospheric medieval castles. Step into a world of legends, mysticism, old customs, music, and theatrical performances as the castle comes alive for the evening. Your celebration includes a buffet dinner, local drinks, and live entertainment with singers, dancers, and actors. The party begins at 7:30 p.m. and continues until midnight, with shuttle service arranged back to your hotel in Hunedoara, if you wish to leave earlier. (B,D)

Day 8 – Hunedoara | Cozia Monastery – Bucharest After breakfast, depart for Bucharest, Romania’s fascinating capital, with a scenic stop en route at Cozia Monastery. Set dramatically on the banks of the Olt River, this remarkable monastery is one of Romania’s great medieval treasures. Founded by Mircea the Elder in the late 14th century and consecrated in 1388, Cozia is admired for its beautiful blend of Byzantine and Wallachian architecture, serene setting, interior frescoes, and the tomb of its founder. A visit here offers a peaceful and enriching glimpse into Romania’s spiritual and artistic heritage. Continue onward to Bucharest, arriving in the afternoon. The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax and settle into the rhythm of the capital. (B)

Day 9 – Bucharest | Return to the USA or Optional Bucharest Extension After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight to the USA, taking with you cherished memories of Romania’s medieval towns, royal castles, mountain landscapes, and rich cultural traditions. Day 9 – Bucharest | Romania’s Elegant Capital Discover Romania’s captivating capital, where elegant Belle Époque architecture, royal landmarks, and communist-era history blend into one fascinating city. Your guided tour begins with a panoramic drive past the Palace of Parliament, National Cathedral, University Square, Victory Square, and the iconic Arch of Triumph. Continue to the beloved Village Museum, an open-air collection of authentic homes, churches, and farmsteads from across Romania, offering a glimpse into centuries of traditional village life. Next, explore Bucharest’s charming Old Town on foot. Highlights include the Romanian Athenaeum, former Royal Palace, former Communist Party Headquarters, Kretzulescu Church, and the lively Lipscani District with its cafés, boutiques, and historic buildings. Enjoy lunch at the legendary Caru’ cu Bere, famous for its traditional cuisine and magnificent Neo-Gothic interior. The afternoon is free to relax at a café or browse for Romanian handicrafts, local wines, and other authentic souvenirs. (B, L)

Day 10 – Bucharest | Inside the Ceaușescu Mansion Visit the former home of Nicolae Ceaușescu and discover one of Bucharest’s most fascinating historic residences. Behind its modest exterior lie beautifully preserved interiors, elegant reception rooms, and lavish décor. As you tour the mansion, your guide shares the story of Romania’s final communist leader, offering insight into an important chapter of the nation’s history. The afternoon is yours to enjoy Bucharest at your own pace. Relax over lunch, savor coffee at a local café, stroll along elegant Calea Victoriei, admire the Romanian Athenaeum, or browse local galleries and specialty shops. (B)

Day 11 – Farewell to Romania After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home. Depart with wonderful memories of Romania’s storybook villages, medieval castles, scenic landscapes, rich traditions, and the timeless elegance of Bucharest—an unforgettable finale to your journey. (B)
